a. CITY AND PLANNING UNIT OUTREACH

The Board will receive a verbal update from Chief Turbeville and Directors Peterson and Abercrombie.

Directors Abercrombie and Newman will present a written framework to promote the advancement of Board objectives and seek input, comments, and/or approval for the following:

c. FIRE STATION UPDATES
